

CANDLE HOLDER 02

Hand-forged from two iron rods, Chandelier 02 is assembled hot and twisted together—one end forming the jaws that grip the candle, the other shaping a stable tripod base. The metal is gradually worked on the anvil, struck and stretched to reveal its final form. The process requires several hours of skilled craftsmanship. Known as a rushlight, this early form of lighting was once common along the Atlantic coast—from Ireland to the Pyrenees, including England and Brittany—until the 20th century. In earlier times, a simple piece of tree resin often stood in for a wax candle.

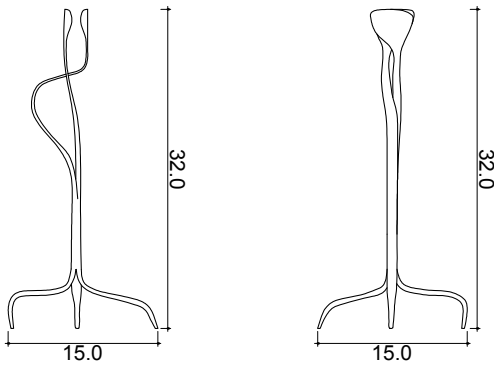
Each Inventaire product is the result of French, manual, and artisanal craftsmanship.

MATERIAL AND TECHNIQUE

Hand-forged and hammered S235 steel. This is a “living” material whose appearance may change over time when exposed to hands, air, water, or other elements. These natural changes contribute to the unique character and aesthetic of each piece.

USE

FINISHING

While still hot, the artisan applies a wax used for the protection and finishing of metal surfaces. The products may feel slightly tacky upon delivery. This effect will quickly disappear when exposed to ambient air. To maintain the long-term protection of your INVENTAIRE iron door handles, you can apply a natural wax yourself. If you wish to enhance the product's shine, you can polish it using a soft brush or a suitable cloth.

PRECAUTIONS FOR USE

Inventaire candle holders are single or double candle stands without wax catchers or drip trays. As a result, wax may drip onto the surface supporting the holder. To prevent wax drips from the burning candle, we recommend using high-quality taper candles. To remove wax drips from the candle holder, avoid using tools that could scratch the object.

Ensure that candle holders are placed on stable, non-slippery, horizontal surfaces.

Keep candle holders out of reach of children, especially when a candle is lit.

IMPORTANT NOTE

The dimensions of the items may vary from one piece to another within a tolerance defined by Inventaire. These variations result from handcrafted work, which introduces unique nuances at each stage of the manufacturing process. These variations do not affect the functionality of the products. They give each piece its own unique character.
