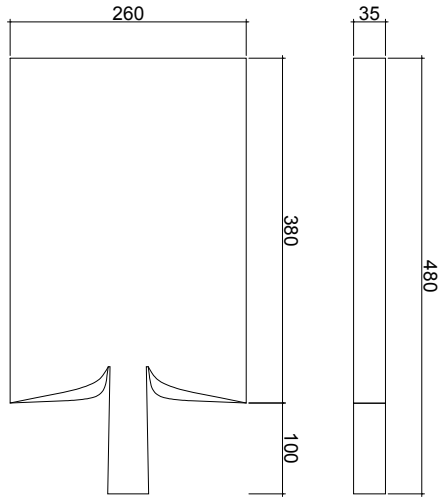


## BOARD 03

Board 03 is a large, rectangular piece with a straight handle. The edges are hand-softened, and a chamfered detail at the handle, created with a wood chisel, provides a better grip. Traditionally common in rural areas, this board is now handcrafted from locally sourced beech, a light wood that darkens with age. Protected with a beeswax-based balm, it is safe for food use. The wood is carefully chosen by artisans who prioritize sustainable forestry practices.

### MANUFACTURING LOCATION

Occitanie region, France.

### MANUFACTURING PROCESS

Each Inventaire product is the result of French, manual, and artisanal craftsmanship.

### MATERIAL AND TECHNIQUE

Solid beech wood.

This is a "living" material whose appearance may change over time when exposed to hands, air, water, or other elements. These natural changes contribute to the unique character and aesthetic of each piece.

### USE

Cutting board or centerpiece.

### FINISHING

The boards are protected with a balm made from beeswax and carnauba wax, a natural and bio-based product suitable for food use. Repeated use may diminish this protection.

If you wish to maintain the protection of your INVENTAIRE wooden boards over time, we recommend regularly applying the maintenance balm, available on our e-shop. If you want to enhance the product's shine, you can polish it using a soft brush or a suitable cloth.

### PRECAUTIONS

The boards are not intended to be washed in the dishwasher, as this would damage their surface and may cause warping.

Using the boards for cutting will cause various marks and wear related to the use of blunt utensils.

If your board becomes stained, we recommend cleaning it with hot water and drying it immediately.

To nourish, protect, and extend the life of your cutting board, we suggest applying the maintenance balm made from beeswax and carnauba wax, available on our e-shop.

### IMPORTANT NOTE

The dimensions of the objects may vary from one piece to another within a tolerance defined by Inventaire.

These variations result from the handmade process, which imparts unique nuances at each stage of production.

These variations do not affect the functionality of the products.

They give each item its unique character.
